The present piece "The way of Equal Distribution" by M. Gandhi is consisted of the principle of equality distribution of wealth in the society. He gives his idea that the distribution of wealth must be brought about through Non-violence. He clarifies that if one man has a weak digestion & requires only a quarter of a pound of flour for his bread & another needs a pound. Both should be in a position to satisfy their wants. He adds that equal distribution should be started from individual policy & it should be necessary change in the personal life of a man. Taking the view of the poverty of India, we should reduce our wants to a minimum point. The earning of the particular should be free of dishonesty.

Gandhijee lays emphasis that the doctrine of equal distribution must be based on the trusteeship of the wealthy for the superfluous wealth possessed by them. The doctrine says that the wealthy person should not possess a one rupee more than his neighbour. This is very clear that violence is needed in the reference of this doctrine. But this is not the remedy or solution of this problem. The only solution of this problem is that the rich man will be left in possession of his wealth, of which he will use what he reasonably requires for his personal needs & will act

as a trustee for the remains to be used for the society. In this way a man should understand himself as the servant of society & there must be Ahimsa' in the venture. such a way there will be a peaceful revolution & not bitterness in the society.
